Basic guide to: Starting A Business in Bath County

- ♦ Make a business plan
- ♦ Once you decide your business physical location *speak with both the County Building inspector and Zoning official that your proposed location is permissible for its proposed use.*
- Decide your desired business structure (LLC, Partnership, S Corp, C Corp, Sole Proprietor)
 - *Should you decide to be an LLC, Partnerships, S Corp, or C Corp, it is recommended you seek legal advice in setting this up and filing the correct paperwork.
 - * Sole proprietors may choose to file a Doing Business As (DBA) form. It is recommended you seek legal advice in the completion and filing of this form.
- ♦ Obtain a FEIN (federal employer identification number), if required, online at www.irs.gov. There is a question and answer section on the IRS website if you are not sure.
- Register your business with Virginia online at www.tax.virginia.gov if required.
- Obtain a state Contractors license, if required, in your line of business.

- ♦ Obtain a Bath County Business license at the office of the Commissioner of the Revenue or online at www.bathcountyva.org.
- Start a separate bank account for your business.
- ♦ It is a good idea to purchase business liability insurance.
- ★ ***Record keeping is essential*** keep all receipts related to business purchases, phone, internet, utilities, insurance, supplies, equipment, bank fees, interest paid on business loans, etc. and keep a log of mileage traveled for business.
 - If you have employees you will be responsible for employer tax
 - **❖** If subject to collecting sales tax, meals tax, transient occupancy tax, tire tax, litter tax, etc. you are responsible for those filings and submissions.
