# **Approval of Minutes:**

• The minutes of the March 8, 2023 Regular Board meeting were approved without changes. (There was no April Board meeting.)

#### **Unfinished Business:**

• The County Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing regarding the change of location of the Burnsville precinct voting location at their May 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. There were no comments. The Board of Supervisors will vote on the issue at their June 13th meeting.

#### **Chairman's Report:**

- Virginia Electoral Board Association (VEBA) Annual Meeting was held at the Hotel Roanoke, Sunday and Monday, March 26 and 27<sup>th</sup>. Nancy, Karen, and Donna attended. A Boot Camp for new EB Board members was held on Saturday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, which Karen attended. Donna attended the GR meetings.

- Nancy brought to our attention a good article that was sent to EB members on How to Work with State Legislators.

### **General Registrar's Report:**

- Review of Electoral Board and General Registrar office budgets.
- Ballot on Demand Donna will see a demo at this year's GR training. Costs for Ballot on Demand would include machine and set up, printer, and paper costs.
- Donna will order van access and handicap access signs for precincts. EB members will review each precinct for van accessible spaces. (Precinct tour set for Wednesday, May 31, 2023.)
- Discussion regarding bilingual ballots for Spanish. Cost per election around \$400 for coding plus the ballot costs and signs.
- Presented the 2023 Voting Security Plan to the Board for approval and signatures.
- The Annual Review of the General Registrar is due to the State on June 30<sup>th</sup>, so must be completed by June 15<sup>th</sup>. (Preparation and discussion of the review by the Board is scheduled for May 31<sup>st</sup>.)
- Split Officers of Election scheduled for Fairview precinct for November election.
