Hours: Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., and Saturdays, June 8 and 15 from 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

Ballot Dropbox is located at the back entrance of the Bath County Courthouse through 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, June 18. In addition, drop boxes will be available at all regular polling places on Election Day, June 18, from 6:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m.

Deadlines:

Monday, May 28, 2024: Last day to register to vote and vote a regular ballot. After that date you can register the same day and vote a provisional ballot at the Office of the General Registrar through the early voting period or on election day June 18, 2024, at your prospective voting precinct.

Friday, June 7, 2024: Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail. Completed applications must be received in the Bath County Voter Registration/Election Office by 5:00 p.m. or online by 11:59 p.m.

Tuesday, June 18, 2024: Election Day ALL DROPPED OFF Absentee Voted Ballots must be returned to the Bath County Voter Registration/Elections Office **Drop Box or at a Drop Box located at any of the 7 voting precincts** by 7:00 p.m. (Virginia time) to be counted.

Friday, June 21, 2024: ALL Absentee voted ballots returned via **MAIL** must be **postmarked by Election Day** and received by the Bath County Voter Registration/Election Office by **NOON** (Virginia time) to be counted.
